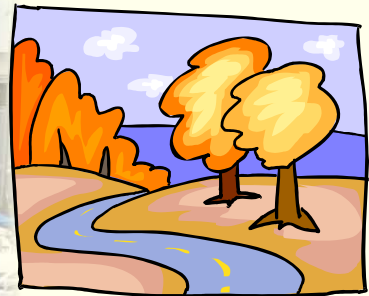
Family & Vacations
