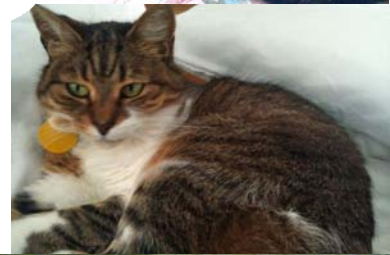


Faneuil Hall when Jeanne visited Boston with her travel camp.
